To Whom it May Concern:

I am writing to request the issuance of a U Nonimmigrant Visa for my client DDR (A#), Sibling of U Nonimmigrant HDR (A#). As indicated in the Notice of Action attached herein at Exhibit B , the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) granted D's U-5 Nonimmigrant Status on [date]. He now seeks to enter the United States to reunite with his sister, who is currently residing in Houston, Texas.

Please find attached the following documents relating to D's eligibility for entry to the United States:

- Exhibit A Confirmation of Submission of DS-160 for DDR
- Exhibit B Copy of approval notice for U-4 Status for DDR
- Exhibit C Copy of approval notice for U-1 Status for HDR, principal applicant

- Exhibit E Birth Certificate for HDR, confirming that D is her Brother, with English Translation
- Exhibit F Birth Certificate for DDR, confirming that he has the same two parents as HDR, the principal
- Exhibit I Childhood Photos showing HDR in Honduras with her family, including DDR.

USCIS has exclusive jurisdiction over the adjudication of Form I-918, Petition for U Nonimmigrant Status (8 C.F.R. § 214.11; FAM 41.85 N3) and the accompanying I-918 Supplement A, Petition for Qualifying Family Member of U-1 Recipient. As described in detail in the FAM materials attached at Exhibit H, aliens with U Nonimmigrant Status who are outside of the United States may request permission to enter the United States. Posts are instructed to confirm that the applicant has an I-797 Notice of Action and verify that approval through the PIMS.
